2022 Laronde Craft Fair Info & Registration Instructions

Hello Crafting Families

As previously announced, The Laronde PAC will host the Annual Laronde Student Craft Fair on Friday November 25, from 2:30 -4:30pm. We are excited to have this event return and look forward to seeing the amazing creativity of our Laronde students. The following contains important information on how to register for this event. Please read carefully.

All students from K to gr.7 are invited to create individual crafts to sell to other students, parents and staff at a nominal price. Parental assistance with the crafts is encouraged, but the crafts are to be primarily student made. Students may work individually or team up to create and sell their wares. (Group maximum size is 3). Students may keep all money earned from the sale of their crafts. In the past, most items have been priced between \$1-\$4.

In light of lingering Covid concerns, we are encouraging a return to a Traditional Craft Format and discouraging food items. Food items that are crafty in nature will be allowed but must be packaged and sealed for take home consumption. (ie, homemade novelty candies etic.) Due to the gym's newly refinished floors, no food or drink is allowed to be consumed in the gym. Unsealed baking items for individual sale will not be allowed. Also, no beverages will be allowed to be sold. If you have any questions, about these guidelines, please email me at the address below.

Parent permission will be required for participation. Parents will also be responsible for supervising and assisting their child during the event including setting up at lunch on the day of the event and leaving their area clean at the end.

There will be a \$4.50 charge per participant to cover the cost of our table rentals. This means a group of two will pay \$9 and a group of 3 will pay \$13.50. All payment this year, will be through School Cash Online. Each vendor will have a reserved space of approximately 2.5 ft to display their crafts; groups of 3 may get a slightly bigger space of 3 ft. Space in the gym is limited, so be sure to register early to avoid disappointment.

Registration for the event will be at lunch on Tuesday November 15 and Wednesday November 16. Please print and fill out the attached form completely and legibly. Please remember to list the crafts that you are selling so that I don't put duplicate crafts at the same table. If you are working in a group, only one form is necessary with one designated parent contact to act as a coordinate for that group. Parent contact information must be filled out as this will be used for all future communications for our crafters. Once your form has been submitted, we will add a charge to those parents School Cash Online Account. This must be paid by Tuesday November 22.

Due to space limitations, we cannot accommodate requests for friends to be put next together. However, we will be able to position older siblings by younger ones so please make a note on the registration form if this applies to you.
