Dear Laronde Parents,

I am pleased to share my year-end report as your PAC Chair. I'd like to first report on a few financial matters. This year we raised \$13,693 through the direct donation campaign and \$15,071 at our Spring Fair (a record-setting amount for a Laronde Spring Fair!) These two main fundraisers, in addition to our popular hot lunch program, ensure that we can continue to support the many enrichment opportunities the Laronde PAC provides for our children. I would like to thank everyone for their generous support of our fundraisers. We voted at the last meeting to transfer 20% of the direct donation money to the playground and playground and/or technology funds. For those new to the school, the beautiful playgrounds you see at Laronde are paid for by parents. We spent the past 10 years fundraising for the replacement of Playground #2 which was opened in early 2022. We now set our fundraising target to the future replacement of Playground #3 which could come in the next 5-10 years. Playground #2 cost us almost \$120,000. I am confident that if we continue to raise similar amounts of funds through cheque writing, hot lunch, and spring fairs, and diligently set money aside, we should be in a good position to replace playground #3 when required.
